

February meeting of the Austin Radio Control Association

Vice President Robin Masek called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. There were 21 members present.

The minutes of the January meeting were read and accepted as read.

The treasurer's report for January was read and accepted as read.

Old business;

Sam Michael asked that a Prang be mailed to his address. Robby Holland volunteered to become the News Letter editor and mail the Prang to those without Internet access.

New business;

After several options presented by Robin Masek, a show of hands indicated that the members decided that a 4 ft high chain link type frame with a nylon safety mesh in front of the pilot stands was the best option. The fence will have a 24"-30" opening in the middle so that the pilots can walk out to the runway to retrieve any planes stuck out on the runway. A motion was made to allocate up to \$1000 for fence materials and passed. March 18th is scheduled to put the frame up and Robby Holland said he would bring out a power auger to dig the holes for the frame poles. The question of the grille was also brought up and a motion to spend up to \$600 for a new grille was made and also passed. Helicopters pilots are reminded that they also need to follow the club rules regarding hovering in the proper places and flying the pattern if they are flying while others are flying.
