Old business;

There will be a minimum prize of \$25 per event. A motion to hold a Club 40 practice race on Mar 10th from 10-2 was made and passed.

New business;

The helicopter pilots were asked to give the club some input as to what improvements they would like to see. They will respond at a later date. Turbine fliers are reminded to have a water fire extinguisher on the flight line when they are flying. A list of projects the club would like to accomplish this spring are as follows

1. Filling the water buffalo, Edwin Smith will look into borrowing a tank to transport water and filling the buffalo.
2. Wash and prep the front and sides of the clubhouse for a fresh coat of paint.
3. Fill the cracks on the runway and center taxiway with sand and seal with tar.
4. Seal the taxiway after the cracks have been filled.
5. Upgrade electrical service in the clubhouse and concession stand.
6. Remove old insulation from back & side walls, reinsulated and cover with plywood on the upper portion and hardi-plank on the lower portion of the walls.
7. Repair any broken or malfunctioning electrical outlets in the RV use area.
8. Renewing the field rules sign, Doug Nelle has volunteered to do that.

This is a lot of work and people will be needed if we are to accomplish these tasks in a timely manner. Come out and help maintain the excellent facility that we have. Pat Callan has started worked on the inside walls and there are materials to repair the cracks at the field now. Total cost for these upgrades will be approximately \$2500, A motion to spend this money was made and passed.

Blue Max Award
